

The meeting was also attended by the project team from both the Khoni Municipality Mayor's Office and CHCA. The parties discussed the activities envisaged by the project and the stages of their implementation.



CHCA has launched a new project!

The new project "Strengthening capacity of members of Ukrainian civil society organizations working on emergency programs in Ukraine and Georgia" is implemented by CHCA together with the Ukrainian partner organization - Center "Women's Perspectives".

Within the framework of the project, a manual will be developed, trainings will be held on the methods of providing practical humanitarian assistance. A digital platform will be created where organizations will be able to effectively update information and provide various services to the population affected by the conflict.

The project is implemented with the financial support of the European Union and The Black Sea Trust for Regional Cooperation.

A memorandum of cooperation between CHCA and College "Lakada" was signed.



The memorandum was signed within the framework of the project "The Initiative for Housing Associations in Eastern Europe (IWO e.V)" and aims to increase access to professional education and support for youth affected by the conflict.

At the meeting, along with the representatives of CHCA and "Lakada" College, Manana Kvachakhia, the adviser to the chairman of the Government of Abkhazia, was present.
